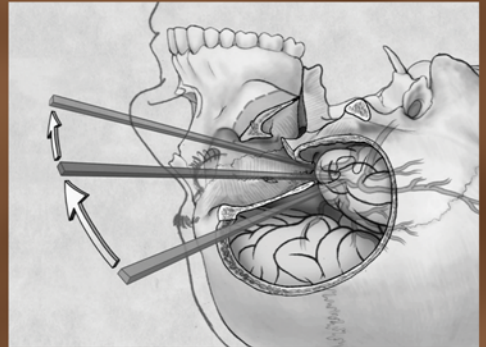
SECOND LEVEL MASTER'S COURSE 2021-2022

The course provides comprehensive theoretical and practical instruction on surgical access to the anterolateral skull base, an anatomically homogenous region.

This one-of-its-kind course features:

- Continuity of learning throughout the year
- Multimodal teaching: hands-on, live surgery, workshops, lessons, etc.
- One cadaver head per participant
- Three 3-day dissection courses on each of the following:
 - transcranial, pterional and variants
 - endonasal and median subfrontal
 - other approaches, including those directed to the orbit
- Multidisciplinary faculty
- Range of techniques from microscopic to endoscopic
- Guided comparison of surgical approaches to the same intracranial area
